

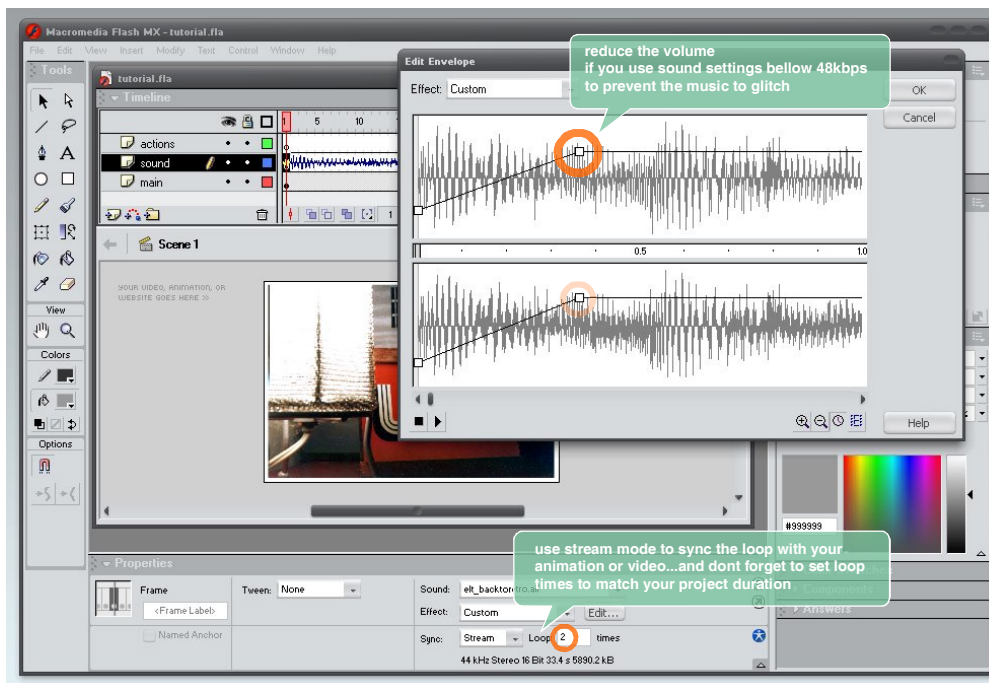


# COMPRESSING SOUND

## basic tutorial about sound inside flash

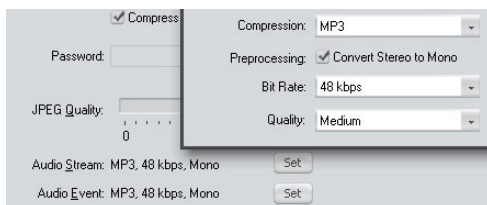


First, import your file into Macromedia Flash - **Choose: File/Import**, your sound will appear in the library. Click on the first frame and select the sound in the properties box.  
// if you need to synchronise the sound with the exact time of the "video, animation, etc.." set the sync mode "in the properties bar" to "stream".  
// if you want the music to always loop and play as background you should use: "event" mode.  
**note:** download our flash source examples on sound control in Macromedia Flash.



// After inset the music into your project - **Choose: File / Publish settings** to set the sound setting.

// We recomend you to set the quality for the web for at least: "56kbps Stereo". If your loop time is very short, you can increase it to higher or maximum quality.



// If the sound is to be used in an application, running from cd-rom or an offline presentation, do not forget to set it to maximum bit rate. In the quality box you may set to "fast" for better performance.
